Dear Families,

We appreciate your continued partnership with us by providing support to your children at home through rich conversations, homework help, extracurricular activities, and ongoing encouragement. To continue to support you as you work with your children in math, the following resources are available to help:

Bounce Pages App

Download the app to scan homework pages for instructional videos that support the concept. You must scan the page *prior* to writing on it and hold the device *completely* still. Further access and troubleshooting tips are included on back.

Pearson Website

Visit <u>www.hcps.org</u> and click on the **enVision Math Logo** in the upper right-hand corner. Follow the directions to log onto the Pearson website. Below is your child's login information—you will want to keep this in a handy place at home:

Pearson Online Resources Available:

- Programs: Click this link to access a specific topic and lesson for instructional videos and interactive problems that students may have completed in class. You can also click the Student e-text link at the top of the lesson page to see a "fixed" copy of the student textbook.
- Classes: Click this link to see possible assignments that have been provided in an online format (note that not all teachers are using this feature at this time). On the right-hand menu, you can also access an interactive version of the student textbook (ACTIVe-book), the Games Center, interactive math tools, and a glossary (note that student books also contain a purple section of vocabulary cards for each topic).
- **Grades:** This section only applies if students have completed online activities assigned by a teacher (again, not all teachers are using this feature at this time). These "grades" are automatically scored electronically through Pearson; however, teachers may choose not to include these assignments as official grades that are reported and posted to EdLine (Grs. 3-5).

Additional Highlights:

- The Games Center (under the Classes Tab) has a variety of fun ways to practice skills. You may select games at other grade levels to extend or reteach by clicking in the upper left-hand corner, "Choose Grade."
- The Interactive version of the student text (under the Classes Tab, ACTIVe-book) allows students to use electronic tools directly on the student pages.
